Location:

Our Bristol centre is located on the Frenchay campus of the University of West of England 3 miles from Bristol city centre. The area is an exciting metropolis close to the Welsh border and alongside the Bristol Channel. Bath is ten miles to the East, Cardiff thirty miles to the West and London is two and a half hours away.

Famous for its seafaring tradition, Bristol is also the home of the Clifton Suspension Bridge, the work of the great architect Isambard Kingdom Brunel. It has an excellent shopping centre as well as up market suburbs like Clifton. It even has a zoo.

Apart from the many attractions of Bristol itself, the surrounding area has much to see and do. Including visits to Bath, Wales and the famous seaside town of Weston-super-mare as well as much more.

Accommodation:

Adjacent to the main university buildings is the newly constructed Student Village. All accommodation is spacious, single ensuite in flats of 6 people. All floors are accessed by lifts. Each flat has a large kitchen/lounge area which is available for pasta parties on request. Each courtyard has its own 24-hour reception area and CCTV. A launderette is also available for students to do washing.

General Information:

Classes are held in the main university building in modern bright rooms.

The centre is equipped with excellent on-site facilities including a new sports centre with 2 sports halls and a dance studio. There are also Astroturf pitches.

In addition there is a large, bright refectory, a spacious Student Union Bar and plenty of outside student social areas.

Bristol’s city centre is only a 20 minute bus ride away, but the campus boasts on site shops and banking facilities for the student’s immediate needs.

Excursions:

Our Bristol centre offers two half day trips and one full day trip per week to such locations as Oxford, Bath and Cheddar Gorge.
