

Mile End - Information Sheet

Location:

Situated in London’s Zone 2, Mile End is a perfect base from which to explore the capital city. Our Mile End summer school is based on the large city campus of Queen Mary, University of London. The campus is situated near the Regent’s Canal.

Accommodation:

Students studying at Queen Mary University of London will be accommodated in very modern en-suite rooms in the Pooley or Maurice Building. All rooms are single and each has its own toilet and shower unit. The en-suite rooms are arranged in flats of approximately 9 rooms sharing a kitchen / common area. There is an internal telephone in each building.

General Information:

Mile end has excellent modern accommodation as well as a large student union for evening events. Local parks are also used for sporting events. The campus has modern classrooms and various lecture theatres which are used for evening events. There is a bank, book shop and a couple of cafes on site.

Excursions:

The programme at Mile End offers 4 half day trips per week into central London by underground. Embassy CES pays for student travel cards into London. There is also a full day trip at the weekends by coach to destinations such as Brighton, Cambridge, Oxford or Canterbury.
