Location:

Our vacation course is based on the UCL (University College London) campus in Malet Street, London WC1. This is an extremely central location in the heart of the West End, just off Tottenham Court Road and close to Oxford Street.

Accommodation:

Campbell East: This hall is only a few minutes walk from the UCL classroom area. It has single and twin bedrooms all with washbasins. There are also kitchens on each floor. There are washbasins in all rooms and shared bath/shower room and toilet facilities in a ratio of approximately 1:5. Students on vacation courses will have their meals Monday to Friday at the main campus canteen and will be issued with meal vouchers at the weekend which can be used in most major restaurants, cafes and supermarkets. Available to groups from 14 years and individuals from 16 years.

Ramsay Hall: Accommodation for both junior and senior vacation course students is available at this hall on Maple Street –just a 5 minutes walk from the classroom area. Rooms are single with a limited number of twins also being available. There are washbasins in all rooms and shared bath/shower room and toilet facilities in a ratio of approximately 1:5.

General Information:

UCL is the ideal centre for those who are interested in a summer school experience in the heart of one of the most cosmopolitan and famous cities in the world. The accommodation hall at Ramsay has a student bar where much of the evening entertainment is held. Those staying at Campbell House are likely to join Ramsay or have some activities around London. Sports are limited to local parks, swimming is offered each week to those who request it.

Excursions:

The programme in UCL includes at least 3 programmed visits to museums or attractions in London each week. Transport for visits in London is not included and is usually by underground. Students will need to purchase travel cards (approximate cost £26 each week for 16s and over and £13 under 16s) to take full advantage of the busy programme. There is also one full day trip at the weekend (usually by coach). Weekend trips are to destinations such as Oxford, Brighton, Cambridge or Canterbury.
