Location:

Seaford is a small seaside town situated on the south coast of England midway between Hastings and Brighton. Seaford rests in the heart of the South Downs - a place of beautiful rolling hills and dramatic coastal landscape; the Seven Sisters being a good example. The South Downs are vibrant with nature and lots of historical interest. The town itself offers excellent shopping and has along flat seafront.

Seaford Summer School is based in Newlands School, a well respected private boarding school situated a few minutes walk from the town centre.

Accommodation:

Students are accommodated in multi bedded rooms (mostly with bunk beds) in two boarding houses in the campus and share communal shower and toilet facilities.

General Information:

The dining hall is a modern bright hall able to seat 200+ diners on a self service basis. There is also a large outside pavilion where barbecues take place once a week weather permitting. Classrooms are well equipped and there is an excellent art room available for arts and craft activities. The school also boasts its own dance studio. Seaford has good sports facilities with an indoor sports hall where table tennis etc can be played as well as out door sports fields offering football, volleyball and baseball. We are also able to make use of the excellent indoor swimming pool on site

Excursions:

Our Seaford Summer School has two half days and one full day trip per week to such places as Hastings Castle, Brighton, Canterbury, Oxford and London.
